
Music Educators of Berks County <u>Jr. County Band Scale Requirements</u> <u>and Percussion Rudiment Requirements</u>

DIATONIC SCALES (ALL SCALES MUST BE MEMORIZED)

Played at a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 100, tongued using the rhythmic pattern shown below.



CHROMATIC SCALES (ALL SCALES MUST BE MEMORIZED)

Played at a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 100, slurred using all eighth notes.

Oboe	D, G, F, Bb, Eb, Ab: 1 Octave	2 Octaves C to C
Bassoon	D, G, C, F, Bb, Eb, Ab: 2 Octaves	2 Octaves F to F
Bb Soprano Clarinet	A, D, G, C, F, Bb, Eb: 2 Octaves	2 Octaves C to C
Eb Alto Clarinet	F, G: 2 OctavesA, D, C, Bb: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
Bb Bass Clarinet	F, G: 2 OctavesA, D, C, Bb, Eb: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
Alto / Tenor / Bari. Saxophone	Eb, D, F, C, Bb: 2 OctavesG, A: 1 Octave	2 Octaves C to C
Bb Trumpet	G: 2 OctavesC, D, A, F, Bb, Eb: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
French Horn	G: 2 OctavesC, D, F, Bb, Eb: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
TC Baritone	G: 2 OctavesC,D,A,F,Bb: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
Trombone / BC Euphonium	F: 2 OctavesBb, C, Eb, Ab, G: 1 Octave	2 Octaves F to F
Tuba	Ab, Bb, C, D, Eb, G, F: 1 Octave	1 Octave Bb to Bb
Mallet Percussion	D, G, C, F, Bb, Eb: 1 Octave	Entire Range
Snare Drum	Flam Accent #1, Tripe Ratamacue, Paradiddle, Flam- Paradiddle, 5-Stroke Roll: All played at tempo MM quarter note = 120; Long Roll, Closed, multiple bounce, soft to loud to soft	
Timpani	Tuning from given pitch to another pitch; Long Roll, single stroke, soft to loud to soft
