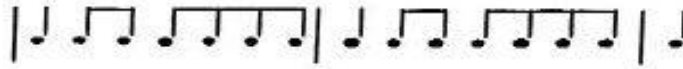

Sr. County Band (District 10) Scale Requirements

DIATONIC SCALES FOR WINDS AND MALLETS

Played at a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 120 (all instruments except French horn, trombone, baritone (BC & TC) and tuba which use a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 100). Scales should be tongued using the rhythmic pattern shown below:



CHROMATIC SCALES FOR WINDS AND MALLETS

Played at a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 120 (all instruments except French horn, trombone, baritone (BC & TC) and tuba which may use a minimum speed of MM quarter note = 100). Scales should be slurred using eighth notes.

Eb Alto Sax / Bari Saxophone	B, E, D, C, F, Bb, Eb: 2 Octaves.....A, G: 1 Octave	2 Octaves C to C
Bb Tenor Saxophone	E, D, C, F, Bb, Eb: 2 Octaves.....A, Ab, G: 1 Octave	2 Octaves C to C
Bb Trumpet / TC Baritone	A, G, C, Bb, Ab: 2 Octaves.....F, E, Eb, D: 1 Octave	2 Octaves C to C
French Horn	A, G, C, F, Bb, Eb, Ab: 2 Octaves.....D, Db: 1 Octave	2 Octaves G to G
Trombone / BC Baritone	G, F, Bb, Ab, Gb: 2 Octaves.....Eb, D, Db, C: 1 Octave	2 Octaves Bb to Bb
Tuba	G, F, Bb, Ab, Gb: 2 Octaves.....Eb, D, Db, C: 1 Octave	2 Octaves F to F
Mallets (4 count roll - last note)	C, F, Bb, Eb, Ab, G, D, A, E.....2 Octaves	2 Octaves C to C
Percussionists Note:	<p>For Sr. County Auditions (Refer to District 10 audition information for additional District 10 percussion requirements)</p> <p>Mallet Audition: A whole note roll (4 counts) is required on the last note of each major scale.</p> <p>Snare Drum: Long Roll and Single Stroke Roll. IN ADDITION, STUDENTS WILL PREPARE A SHORT RUDIMENTAL ETUDE THAT WILL BE POSTED ON THE MEBC WEBSITE. The roll will be worth 5 points, and the etude will be worth 10 points, for a total of 15 points.</p> <p>Timpani Audition: Tune a major triad from a given fundamental (root, major third, and perfect fifth). Play a <i>sfz</i> roll with a <i>crescendo</i> and <i>decrescendo</i> on the drum tuned to the major third.</p>
